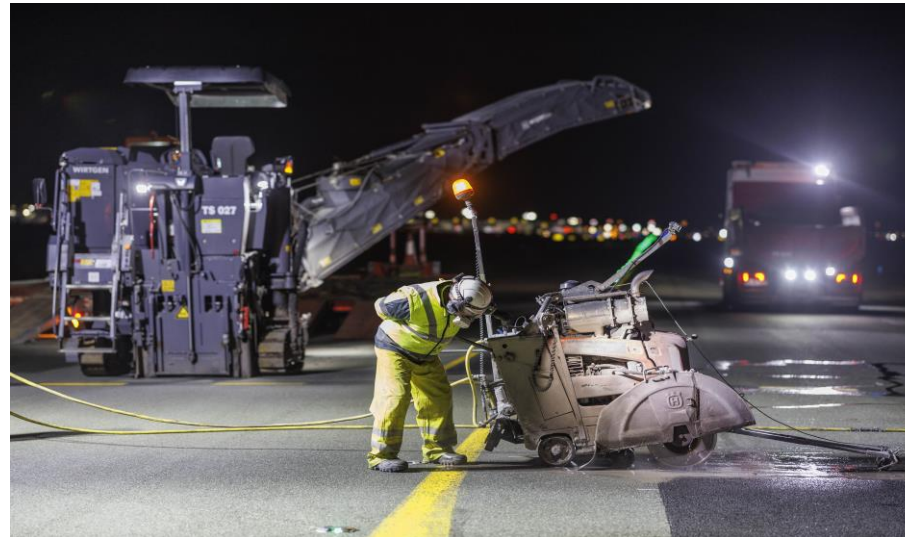

- In February, Dublin Airport welcomed over 2.1m passengers. daa are continuing to work proactively with the airlines and the Irish Aviation Authority as the slots regulator with a view to managing capacity.
- The Community Fund has now opened for applications for a six-period and will close on Friday, April 19.
- The recent essential maintenance works were scheduled to take place over four consecutive nights from Monday March 11 to Thursday, March 14 however inclement weather meant that only two nights of works took place.
